## Principals Report

**Staged Return to Onsite Learning** - It was so lovely to see all our students onsite for at least a few days throughout week. Our staged return will continue, as outlined below, until all students return to onsite learning from Friday.

### Week 3

*Mon 18 Oct – Fri 22 Oct* Students in Foundation, Gr 1 and Gr 2 will continue learning from school.

*Mon 18 Oct – Thu 21 Oct* Vulnerable students and students of authorised workers may attend onsite supervision

*Tue 19 Oct – Wed 20 Oct* Students in Gr 3 and Gr 4 will return to onsite learning - Tue, Wed and Fri.

*Thu 21 Oct* Students in Gr 5 and Gr 6 will return to onsite learning - Thu and Fri

*Fri 22 Oct* - All students return to learning from school

**Year 3-6 Students to Wear Face Masks** - To support the safe return to onsite learning, the Victorian Chief Health Officer has announced new rules around mask wearing to keep everyone at school safe. One of the most important and effective things we can do to help keep students in the classroom is to wear masks to help minimise COVID-19 transmission risk.

When worn properly, masks can play an important role in reducing the transmission risks of Covid-19 that could happen from common activities in school. Face masks are required for all school students in Grade 3 and above indoors including at Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) programs, unless a lawful exception applies. Face masks can be removed while outdoors at school for primary students. Face masks are also strongly recommended for Prep to Year 2 students.

Face masks are required for students in Year 3 to Year 6 unless an exception applies. Exceptions include students with a physical or mental disability where their disability means it would not be suitable. Parent/carers of a student/s who meet the criteria for an exception must provide their approval in writing for their child/ren to not wear a mask to the school. We encourage you to discuss wearing masks with your child to keep kids in the classroom and minimise COVID transmission risk. **Update on our Natural Playspace** - Mr Freeman and I meet with a representative from the Victorian Schools Building Authority last week to review the draft concept plans for our Natural Playspace and to finalise a few details before it is sent out to tender in the next few weeks. It is so exciting to think that after such a long wait steps are now progressing towards the development of our beautiful new playspace. Once the tender process is completed, final plans will be drawn up and as long as everything goes to plan, works will begin in Term 1 next year.

**Update on our Junior Unit Verandah** - Due to the challenges of COVID, our new verandah was not able to be built during the last few school holiday periods, but everything is looking promising that these works will take place over the January holiday break. If everything goes to plan, our Junior Unit students will have lovely new verandahs to shade them from the weather when they return to school in Term 1 2022.

**Lapathon Thank You** - Thanks to your wonderful support, we have raised just over **\$12,500** for our 2021 Lapathon Fundraiser. This money will go towards some new sports equipment and the resurfacing of our basketball/netball court. Thanks everyone, great effort!!! Congratulations to Room 3 and their families for raising \$2000 and qualifying as our highest fundraisers. These students were awarded the coveted SPS Lapathon Trophy and enjoyed their 'Lunch Party' last week.

**2022 Class Placements** - In preparation for the new school year, teachers will be investing a great deal of time over the coming weeks considering our 2022 classroom placements in their endeavour to find just the right balance between the social and learning needs of students in every classroom, and across all year levels. If you feel that a particular circumstance requires consideration, please put this in writing and send it through to my email address [Cindi.Bruechert@education.vic.gov.au](mailto:Cindi.Bruechert@education.vic.gov.au) by **Friday 22 October**, so that your thoughts can be taken into consideration when we formulate our 2022 classes.

**2022 Enrolments** - If you have a child starting at Strathfieldsaye PS next year and you haven't already submitted an enrolment form, please do so as soon as possible. We are planning to hold our 2022 Foundation Transition sessions at the end of October and to conduct our Whole School Transition session on Tuesday 7 Dec which is the State-Wide Orientation Day, so please let us know if you are aware of any students planning to join our school community next year.

**Term 4 Curriculum Days** - On **Wednesday 10 November**, all our school staff will be participating in Day 2 of the Berry St Education Model Training so this day will be a Pupil Free Day. This session was initially planned for the start of August but had to be delayed due to COVID restrictions. On **Friday 10 December**, we will be holding a Curriculum Day to allow our teachers to work together in their 2022 teams to plan next year's literacy, numeracy and inquiry learning units. Students are not required to attend school on this day.





However, we felt that the children shouldn't have to miss out for another year, especially given all the upheaval that they have faced. As a result, our **'Kids Fun Fair'** will be held during school hours on **Friday November 19th between 12:30-3pm.**
