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2024 Curriculum Contributions

In line with the Department of Education and Training Parent Payments Policy, Strathfieldsaye Primary School identifies the items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum. These curriculum contribution items and activities are school based therefore they vary across different schools based on local needs and circumstances, and they reflect each school's priorities, decisions, and resources. They are voluntary financial contributions that families can make to support the school and their child's learning and they are recommended and approved by school council each year.

The *Curriculum Contributions* component consists of consumable curriculum items and activities that are purchased for student use to facilitate learning. They include items and activities such as *General classroom materials and equipment* (e.g. shared classroom stationery, paper, posters/charts, craft items, classroom libraries, readers), *Subject specific materials and equipment* (e.g. materials for English, Mathematics, Language, Science, Art, Music, Physical Education), *Provision and upkeep of school devices, peripherals and ICT* (e.g. devices owned by the school, class sets, device configuration, maintenance, server/system costs), *Photocopying and printing for students* (e.g. printed learning resources), *Digital and online subscriptions for learning* (e.g. Mathletics, Reading Eggs), *Assessments* (e.g. online standardised testing including Essential Assessment), and *Student planners or diaries*.

The costs of these consumable curriculum items and activities are outlined under the following budget areas and a breakdown of how these school council recommended curriculum contributions are calculated is as follows:
